Registration

- » PPE Provided to all attendees at event registration, including a reusable mask and sanitizer. Attendees may also bring masks.
- » Practicing safe and strategic line queuing at registration and throughout the event to enable the practice of social distancing, regulate attendance and disperse crowding in lobbies and waiting areas.

On-site Medical

- » Text-based daily COVID health survey that screens for risk of COVID infection
- » Temperature Checks each day before entering the event
- » Monitoring and enforcing health security policies, including social distancing and sanitation
- » COVID-19 Health Security Plan

Event Venues

- » Hand sanitizer stations positioned throughout the meeting space
- » Responsible F&B, event seating, and barriers where applicable
- » Appropriate Signage/floor decals to reinforce spatial distancing and other safety reminders
- » Require attendee self-reporting and FSG maintenance of contact-tracing communication post-event

Attendee Personal Accountability Commitment

- » All event attendees must agree to abide by and engage in certain health-and-safety-beneficial conduct while attending our events. Including, but not limited to, submitting to daily temperature checks, always wearing a mask in public areas, engaging in appropriate physical distancing, and not attending the event if ill or recently exposed to COVID-19.
