Onsite Protection

FSG works with the venue to ensure we maintain the highest standards of hygiene and cleanliness. We will ensure that each venue undergoes a deep clean before the event, with additional cleaning measures in place throughout the duration of the event.

- » Hand sanitizer stations will be available upon arrival and positioned throughout the meeting space.
- » PPE kits will be available at registration for general attendee use.
- » Food safety protocols and barriers will be implemented where applicable.
- » Event seating and traffic flow may be managed by use of one-way systems and strategic line queuing to ensure social distancing, regulate attendance, and disperse crowding.
